Staff in the school are busy putting together a programme for Transition Year which is proposed for September 2010. Students from third year will partake and we have also opened it out to outside applicants who would like the challenge of a "TY through Irish". Among the proposed developments are subjects like environmental studies, enterprise, local

heritage, social awareness and technology.

It is a critical aim in TY to foster a strong commitment to Self-Directed learning – i.e. that students take responsibility for their own learning. Skills will be developed around problem-solving as well as in research methods, communication skills and technology.

According to the latest national research students who undertake TY outperform those who go straight through to 5th year as well as equipping them better to cope with the challenges of Third Level. We are eagerly anticipating an exciting, challenging and thoroughly enjoyable TY. (A brochure is now available from the school).
